Understand Your Tenancy Rights

As a tenant in British Columbia, you are protected under the Residential Tenancy Act, which ensures your rights and responsibilities as a renter. Key points include:

- You have the right to live in a safe and well-maintained property.
- Landlords must provide proper notice for rent increases or entering the property.
- Tenants are responsible for paying rent on time and maintaining the property in good condition.

Tips to Avoid Housing Scams

To protect yourself during your housing search:

- Never send money before viewing the property in person or virtually through a trusted source.
- Be cautious of deals that seem too good to be true—they often are.
- Verify rental listings by cross-checking details on multiple platforms or contacting landlords

Renters insurance is highly recommended to protect your personal belongings from theft, fire, or other unexpected events. It is an affordable way to ensure peace of mind during your stay in Vancouver.
